Alumni Survey Background:

Bachelor degree recipients from 2010-11 were surveyed during spring quarter 2012 on a variety of questions, including job placement information. Alumni received an online survey and reminder messages and 27% responded.

Note: An average response rate for this type of survey is 30%.

Of the survey respondents, 12% of the alumni are pursuing advanced degrees. Of those attending a graduate school, all of them (100%) stated that the education received from Seattle Pacific was "excellent/good" in preparing them for graduate school.
