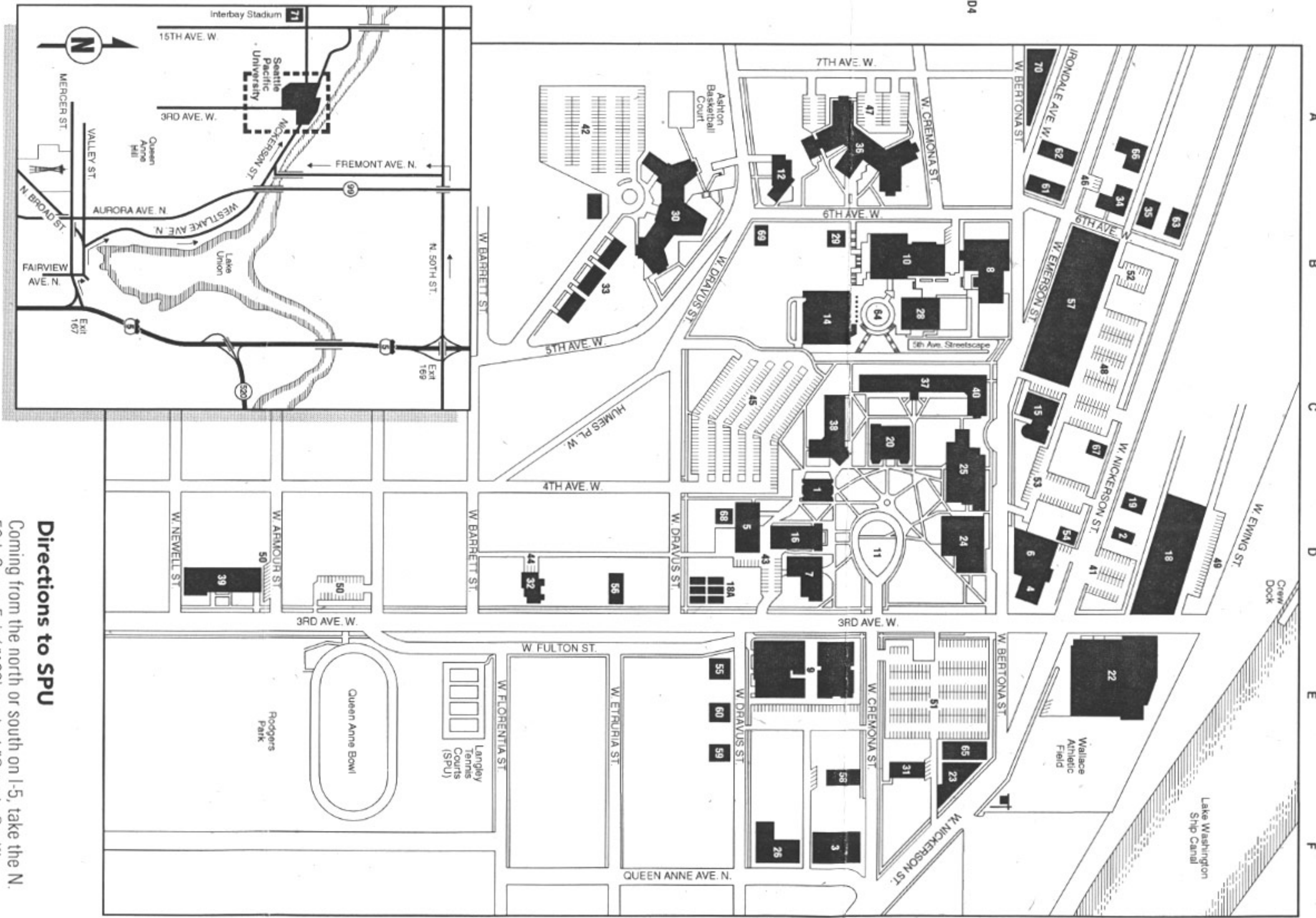

Directions to SPU

Coming from the north or south on I-5, take the N. 50th Street Exit (#169) marked "Seattle Pacific University." Turn west onto N. 50th and proceed to Fremont Avenue N. Turn left onto Fremont and cross the Fremont Bridge. Turn right immediately after the bridge onto Florentia Street. Go one block and turn right onto Nickerson Street. Continue on Nickerson to Third Avenue W. and turn left. You are now on campus. Remain on Third for three blocks, then turn right onto W. Dravus Street and right again into the tiered parking lot (#45 on the map).

General Guest Information

As a service to Summer Session Housing guests, a designated area of a traditional residence hall has been reserved for your summer lodging needs. Guests are assigned one person per room, and gender is kept separate by wing or floor. The following information is designed to answer any additional questions you may have regarding your SPU summer lodging.

Check-in

Monday through Friday, 7 a.m.-7 p.m., check-in is conducted by the Conference Services staff. After-hours check-in is available through the Office of Safety and Security, which is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Arrangements for check-in must be made a minimum of seven days prior to your arrival.

Dining

Your daily room rate includes dinner at our award-winning dining commons. Meals are "all-you-care-to-eat." You may opt to purchase additional meals and pay at the door.

Linens

Towels, sheets, a blanket and pillow are provided at no additional charge. Towels and sheets are exchanged weekly.

Map

A campus map is provided on the reverse side of this brochure.

Parking

Parking is available in lot number 42. (See map on reverse side.) A parking pass or permit is not required.

Pets

Only animals required for ADA purposes are permitted in campus housing.

Policies

Seattle Pacific University is an evangelical Christian institution that by custom and conviction does not allow the use, consumption or possession of alcohol or illegal drugs on campus. We ask your cooperation in honoring the Seattle City Ordinance and our school policy forbidding smoking in any campus building. We reserve the right to discontinue service to any individual who does not comply with University regulations. Under these circumstances the individual will be asked to leave at his or her own expense.

Reservations

To reserve your housing, complete the enclosed application, sign the form and return it along with your full payment (check, MasterCard or VISA) to SPU, ATTN: Conference Services, 3307 Third Avenue West, Seattle, Washington 98119. Reservations are processed in the order in which they are received. A letter of confirmation will be sent upon receipt of your paid housing reservation.

Guest Room Information

Keys

You will be given your room key when you check in. Please return this key when you check out. Room keys not returned at check-out will be deemed lost. The replacement cost is \$65.

Liability

When staying on the Seattle Pacific University campus, you assume the responsibility for your room and its contents. The University is not responsible for loss or damage to personal property.

Room Repairs

Please let us know of any physical problems with your room (i.e., burned-out light bulbs and broken blinds) by calling Conference Services. We will do our best to respond promptly.

Telephones

Telephone service is complimentary and allows you to make local calls from your room. Long distance calls may be made from your room by using a calling card or calling collect. Pay phones are also available in the residence hall lobby and in most other campus buildings. For on-campus calls, dial only the last four digits of the phone number. To call off-campus, press "9" and then the phone number.
