1. You must be admitted to a graduate degree program, an undergraduate degree program (for post-baccalaureate students) or the principal certificate program, school superintendent certificate program, program administrator certificate program or school counseling certificate program at Seattle Pacific University. Other certification programs are not eligible for Federal financial assistance.
2. You must be enrolled each quarter in a minimum of six SPU credits if you are a post-baccalaureate student or three SPU credits if you are a graduate/doctoral student. Only courses that count toward your degree/certificate requirements are eligible for financial aid.
