**Important Note on Graduates: Usually 8-15 students graduate each year. There were 34 graduates in 2006-07 since many were waiting for APA Accreditation. In all prior years, we have a total of fifty-two graduates from our clinical psychology doctoral program. **37% of prior grads are licensed psychologists; many are psychotherapists with other licenses (LMHC); about 10% are academics; and others have post-doctoral positions.*
