





(Search History)



Every year, the United States alone contributes 97 billion pounds of carbon dioxide to the atmosphere from energy that is wasted by power devices when they are plugged in and powered off. This is called idle power consumption, and it a silent thief that greatly impacts the environment. That 97 billion pound waste is the equivalent of every citizen of the US throwing 42 bags of trash into the air every year, thus contributing to 1% of the world's carbon emissions annually.

According to both the Environmental Protection Agency and Energy Star, the average U.S. household spends \$100 per year to power devices while they are off (or in standby mode).

Sarbanes-Oxley Act of 2002 was created to provide oversight for the nation's major companies and a special oversight board to regulate public accounting firms that audit the financial records of these corporations.


Ethics is the branch of philosophy that focuses on morality and the way in which moral principles are applied to everyday life.
