SERVE Internship Grant Criteria

- Internship is with a non-profit, 4013(C) organization or government agency and is unpaid.
- Student will not be supervised by a relative.
- Internship is off campus and not student teaching.
- Internship is relevant to the student's educational goals or stated vocational interests.
- Internship will be primarily devoted to quality activities designed to stimulate learning towards educational goals and vocational interests. Clerical/menial tasks will not exceed 20% of time spent.
- Internship site supervisor will provide consistent feedback and guidance. The frequency and methods
 of this feedback will be clarified in advance.
- Grants are awarded to original proposals and cannot be transferred to an internship at a different site or for another position.
- Applications for a second experience with the same agency or organization must show increased responsibility or significant difference in duties.
- Reflection papers are due at week five and ten. Assignments and due dates will be emailed to students receiving the grant.
- Interns must work a minimum of 10 hours per week for a minimum of 10 weeks.
