

SoulCare Leader Job Description 2022–23

SoulCare leaders are Christian undergraduate students who meet weekly with a small group of UFDN 1000 students to ask and answer the question, "How goes it with your soul?" Leaders are mentored by a seminarian and receive ongoing leadership training through a free* one-credit class (THEO 3780/4780). This position is a year-long commitment of up to 3-5 hours per week, and leaders are paid approximately \$300 per quarter. *Free overload credit (if taking 19 or more credits).

Leader Responsibilities

- 1. Attend a pre-quarter Orientation, once per quarter
- 2. Register for and attend the weekly Leader Training class each quarter*
 - THEO 3780 (new leaders) Autumn Quarter, Wednesdays, 5:30 6:30 pm
 - THEO 4780 (returning leaders) Autumn Quarter, Wednesdays, 7:00 8:00 pm
- 3. Lead your Wesleyan Small Group:
 - Ask and discuss the question, "How goes it with your soul?"
 - Cultivate a safe and sacred space for all group members
 - Establish WSG Ground Rules and hold the group accountable to them
- 4. Track group attendance weekly via Canvas (by 3pm on Fridays)
- 5. Attend weekly mentor group meeting (TBD, scheduled with mentor)
- 6. Schedule 2 one-on-ones with mentor per quarter (1st one by week 5, 2nd one by week 9)
- 7. Complete feedback surveys
- 8. Complete and submit Banner timesheets
- 9. Be attentive to email communication
- 10. Maintain minimum 2.75 GPA

*THEO 3780/4780 meets weekly as a class Autumn Quarter. In Winter and Spring Quarters, leaders register for THEO 4780 for the credit, although the class does not meet.
