## Suggested Course Sequence Sheet (2022-2023)

This is a sample schedule of sequencing for the Politics, Philosophy, & Economics (PPE) major. The first two years of PPE curriculum lay a foundation of theories, concepts, and competencies, which support upper division and track courses later in your academic career. Be sure to regularly review your Degree Status Check in Banner to make sure you are on track with all of your degree requirements. The minimum of 89 credits required is significant and requires careful course planning.
