International Traveler Conditional Vaccination Exemption Request Form

This form may be used to request a conditional and temporary exemption from the requirement of COVID-19 vaccination when the student does not have access to approved COVID-19 vaccines prior to arrival on campus. Page 1 of this form must be completed and signed by the student or parent/guardian (if student is under 18) and submitted to Health Services before traveling to campus and by 8/1/2021. To be eligible for this exemption the student must plan to begin the vaccination series for COVID-19 as soon as possible or by day 8 after arrival in the United States. The student must submit page 2 of the form to Health Services, completed and within 45 days of arrival.

- I will obtain a pre-travel viral test, which must be completed within 72 hours of travel departure. I will report the test result to Health Services as soon as possible. If the result is positive, I will not travel.
- I will obtain a post-travel viral test, which must be within 3-5 days after arrival in the US.
- I agree to obtain immunizations as recommended by Health Services upon arrival to the U.S.
- I will submit documentation of all tests and vaccinations once they are complete, using page 2 of this form.

International Travel and Conditional Exemption Protocol Autumn 2021

All International SPU student travelers are required to meet SPU Immunization requirements for COVID-19 vaccination before arrival on campus in the autumn of 2021 and submit documentation to Health Services by 8/1/2021.

COVID-19 vaccines accepted to meet this requirement include all vaccines currently approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and the World Health Organization (WHO).

International SPU travelers are urged to follow the <u>CDC</u> recommendations for travel based on their immunization status. The CDC urges anyone who is travelling internationally to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. All travelers are urged to wear a well-fitting face covering in all public spaces, avoid crowds and maintain 2-meter distances from others, and wash hands frequently.

Incoming International students, as well as any other SPU student or employee, who is either fully immunized against COVID-19 with an approved vaccine series or has documentation of COVID-19 infection within 90 days prior to travelling, should have a negative COVID-19 test no more than 3 days before travel and self-monitor for symptoms of COVID-19 for 14 days after travel.

Incoming International SPU travelers who are not able to access an approved vaccine prior to traveling to the US should seek a conditional exemption from Health Services by 8/1/2021. A conditional exemption is a temporary exemption from full vaccination status during which time, the individual has an active plan to obtain immunizations on an agreed upon schedule with Health Services. These students should follow CDC travel recommendations for unvaccinated people and obtain a negative viral test no more than 3 days before travel AND retest 3-5 days after travel. They will be required to quarantine for a minimum of 7 days after arrival in the US even with a negative test. New symptoms or positive tests should be reported immediately to Health Services and will require a period of Isolation. They will need to obtain their first dose of approved COVID-19 vaccine between days 8-10 after arrival in the US. Test results, quarantine location and vaccine information should be included on the conditional exemption form.

Conditional Exemption forms are available by request from <u>Health Services</u> or the <u>International Student Services</u> offices and need to be submitted to Health Services for review through the electronic portal by 8/1/2021.
