WHEREAS, **Arthur K. Ellis** has provided Seattle Pacific University with 33 years of remarkable service as a Professor of Education;

WHEREAS, he has published dozens of peer-reviewed articles on social studies education and reflective learning;

WHEREAS, he created the Center for Global Curriculum Studies in the School of Education, partnering with academic institutions around the world;

WHEREAS, he has written numerous books about reflective assessments alongside textbooks for social studies instruction that have influenced generations of educators;

WHEREAS, he was instrumental in developing the doctoral program in the School of Education in the 1990s;
