For me, the very first thing that draws me into a game is being able to play a cool character. When I look at the characters for Destiny, everything from the armor to the color palettes excites me. I am so passionate about creating cool and unique characters, and I think it would be awesome to work with other designers to create new characters for Destiny.

For my background, I am an Illustration major about to complete my degree at Seattle Pacific University. After completing my schooling, I am ready with a mind full of ideas, as well as many new skills, and I am very adaptable. My work background includes being the sole illustrator for the Lingua Journal at Seattle Pacific University (September 2019-June 2020). This involved making cover designs for two editions of the journal, one for winter and one for spring. I had to present my concepts for the journal cover to a team, and receive feedback to develop an idea for the journal cover, and then create digital cover art for print. I also created posters for our events, two logos, portraits of everyone on the team, social media illustrations, and merchandise. My experience other than Lingua includes participating in Branded, in which I learned how to work with a team to present a complete brand. I also made commissions for Kate Bischoff. I worked with her ideas for her song covers, and made two paintings out of gouache for her song covers. I have also worked several jobs at restaurants, including ChocMo and Homegrown, where I have learned how to communicate with costumers, have good time management, and work in a team.
