Enrollment Statistics: Autumn headcounts, diversity and student profiles; incoming new-student profile by average GPA and SAT scores; retention and 6-year graduation rates, etc.

How to use the dashboard - window to greater detail:

Since this is a secured site and open to only deans, department chairs, or their designates, you will be asked to log in after you click on the selected topic. You log into the secured system by entering your user name and password when prompted — the same information you enter when logging onto your campus computer.

Deans and Dept Chair Dashboard:

Access to the information within the "boxes" is restricted and requires you to follow the following process:

- Select a highlighted link for instance "Degrees Awarded"
- 2. You will now go to the "Confluence" page where you will enter your credentials <u>Username</u> (e.g. jward) and <u>password</u> (same as when you log on to your campus PC).
- 3. You only need to enter your credentials once. Now you have access to all the Deans & Dept Chairs reports, as well as the Faculty & Staff dashboard.
- **4.** Your PC will open onto the "Degrees Awarded by Major & Program". See next page as an example.
