Commencement Speaker



LYNETTE BIKOS, PHD, ABPP

Dr. Lynette Bikos joined Seattle Pacific's Department of Clinical Psychology in 2005, and has served as associate dean of the School of Psychology, Family, and Community since 2013. As a professor and director of research, Dr. Bikos teaches statistics, research methods, and psychometrics courses to students enrolled in the clinical and industrial-organizational PhD programs. Her research focuses on the intersections of vocational, international, and sustainable psychology. She is particularly interested in understanding how individuals respond to change.

Dr. Bikos has researched global learning outcomes in returnees from study abroad, first-year adaptation of expatriate spouses, and career development in response to a calling-infused career intervention. During the COVID-19 pandemic, she is investigating experiences of,

and attitudes toward, wearing cloth face masks. Whether online or around a table, planning, implementing, analyzing, and discovering with her advisees is one of her greatest joys.

Dr. Bikos received her doctorate at the University of Kansas-Lawrence. She presently serves on the editorial boards of the Journal of Vocational Development, Career Development Quarterly, and International Perspectives in Psychology: Research, Practice, Consultation. She is board-certified in counseling psychology and is a fellow in the Western Psychological Association.

History of Academic Clothing

The traditions surrounding academic regalia — gown and cap — date back to the 13th century and have their roots in clerical garments, which were the earliest form of academic attire in England. The academic gown was first used at the University of Cambridge in 1284. American universities adopted the first Intercollegiate Code of Academic Costume in 1895. The American Council on Education later standardized the use of academic regalia in 1932.

Originally adopted as a way of affirming unity in the common pursuit of learning, as well as ensuring warmth in unheated stone buildings, academic regalia is now considered traditional attire for high-ceremony academic occasions. Participants wear regalia that demonstrates — by design and color — their highest academic degree, the general discipline in which they studied, and the university from which they received their degree.

At Commencement, master's and doctoral graduates wear the tassel for their mortarboard cap or tam on the left side. Faculty members participating in academic ceremonies also wear the tassel to the left. It is customary for men to remove their caps during prayer.

Seattle Pacific University proudly participates in this colorful tradition, which recognizes our part in the larger academic community and celebrates the importance of Commencement as a high ceremony.

Academic Seal and University Mace

In addition to academic clothing, Seattle Pacific University's Commencement ceremonies include two other important features. The academic seal depicts SPU's history, academics, and Christian faith. The University mace, which bears the academic seal, represents the authority of the president. The mace always precedes the president in academic high ceremonies.

President's Citation Award

The President's Citation is awarded to one graduating master's or doctoral student each year. The recipient of this award exemplifies the mission and vision of this University, is among those with the highest academic standing in their class, and has demonstrated high character, outstanding leadership, and service to the Seattle Pacific community and beyond.
